For a while, Bucks Fabricating put a hold on manufacturing small cans. While some small can and roll-off manufacturers may only offer a single small can solution, Bucks Fabricating offers both front and rear load designs. Let's talk more about a rear load small can.

Rear load containers are used in conjunction with rear loader garbage trucks. These trucks are equipped with grasping hooks mounted at the rear opening of the truck that hook onto the trunnion bars. When locked in place and paired with a tip bar and/or chain on the pickup hooks, the hydraulic operation of the truck allows the container to be easily lifted and emptied.

Available in sizes ranging from 2 to 8 yards, rear load small cans manufactured with a reinforced lifting point, also known as the pick-up hook, and trunnion bar, rear load containers have durable design that is built to last. The plastic lid design features a



six-knuckle hinge line that has a 30% greater thickness than other standard style lids and allows for little to no water retention. The 3/4" drain hole and plastic plug provides a simple and efficient way to empty out any unwanted liquids, such as rain that may fill up in the container and add unnecessary weight. Casters are available for added mobility on 2 and 4 yard sizes. Before the Trash BoxTM is primed and painted, Bucks Fabricating has a prep team that scrapes, cleans, and inspects the container, ensuring a smooth and long-lasting finish.



The rear load Trash Box[™] containers are ideal for general trash collection for both residential and commercial, recycling, and more. They are often seen in confined spaces, such as cities, apartment facilities, and office buildings, due to the small footprint for both the container and the truck.
